

Packing laptops on a EU pallet

Tier1Asset A/S (T1A)

Cover the pallet

1

Place a piece of carton on the pallet. Split into four even rectangles. (Fig.1)

2

Align the laptop with the back towards centerline facing the side of the pallet. (Fig.2.)

3

Place the laptops back-to-back and front-to-front.

4

In the next layer place the laptops with screens down. (fig.4.)



Carton absorbs the moist and protects the laptops from dirt.

Next layers

1

In the third layer the laptops should be placed bottom-to-bottom. (fig. 5)

2

Repeat the same procedure until 10th layer. (Fig.6)

3

Cover the laptops with bubble wrap, and fix with tape. Isolate the pallet with black protective cover. (Fig.7)

4

Attach the KO-number and the **Caution** sign on all sides.

Load maximum 10 layers to avoid weight damaging the bottom layers.
